Officially, the Meiringen Air Base was first operational on December 1st, 1941. Its opening coincided with the year 1941 of the Second World War, a time when things looked pretty grim for Switzerland's further existence. Where do we stand today? 3. Weather/Climate

The scheduled time for the event is the end of the high summer time in Switzerland

- The Swiss climate is generally temperate
- Sunrise 06.40 – Sunset 20.20 at the end of august
- Temperature in late august: around 22 to 28 ° Cel.
- Humidity in late August: around 50%
- Mostly stable weather period in late summer
- Some thunderstorms during and late afternoon possible

4. Accommodations

Hotels, Chalets, Appartements:

There are many hotels and appartements, including chalets and camping close to the contest site where the competition will be held. 5. Food

- Many of the hotels offer a complimentary Swiss Breakfast
- Most of the hotels are near major restaurants and several have restaurants located within their hotels
- Lunch will be available for purchase at the event site at reasonable prices
- Dinner each evening will be at a local restaurant of your choosing; except for the Nations Night and the Closing Banquet

- A special location in Meiringen “Down-Town” is provided as the IJMC meeting point for the daily “get together”, more information in the next bulletins
- The “opening party” will be held at the event site at no cost to the participants
- Nations night will be held on Monday, August 26th; tickets will be available for purchase during team check-in; ticket price will be announced in a future bulletin
- The closing banquet and price giving ceremony will be held on Saturday, August 31st, tickets will be available for purchase during team check-in; ticket price will be announced in a future bulletin

8. Official Language

- English is the official language of the IJMC, and will be used throughout the competition, additional and local language is German (Swiss German, Bernese dialect)

9. Registration

a) General Information

- On-line registration begins on November 1, 2012 (www.jwm2013.com)
- Last day to register is March 31, 2013
- Any registrations received after March 31, 2013 may not be honored
- Complete all forms and provide requested photos of all team members (team manager, pilots, helpers, and supporters) and models
- Registrations without photos cannot be accepted as your picture becomes a part of a pass for your access to restricted areas (see additional guidance in paragraph 9d below)
- Your prompt registration will better insure your acceptance as a competitor
- Early registration will also enable us to organize the event in the best possible manner and will help us to make sure that everything will be arranged and ready for your arrival
- The registration includes only the registration fees for attending the competition: Team Manager, Pilots, Helpers & Supporters and cover all costs for the competition, not fuel
- All other orders and payments for social activities (such as Nations Night and the Closing Banquet or the separate tourist excursions) will be advised prior the event by bulletin and/or official website. More about it and details are done separately during the arrival/check-in process at the JWM event location, paid in local currency CHF to obtain your own voucher for participating

- The organisers of the Jet World Masters 2013 together with Haslital Tourist Organisation participate at the International Jet Power Fair in Bad Neuenahr in Germany from september 16th to september 18th 2012 for further information and booking

b) Deadline for Teams Registration: Forms 1 - 4

- The Team Manager will complete Registration Forms 1 – 4 and send them as soon as possible but no later than March 31, 2013

c) Registration Form Instructions

Registration Forms are

- Form 1 - Team Manager, Pilots, & Helpers
- Form 2 - Photographs for Team Manager, Pilots, and Helpers
- Form 3 - Supporters and Photographs for Supporters
- Form 4 - Model details and photographs

Supporter's late registration

- In order to have as many Supporters as part of the Teams, we will accept Supporter's registration until May 31, 2013
- These registrations need to be submitted on Form 3 and signed by the Team Manager.

All completed registration forms must be sent by Team Managers only. All forms should be sent to: registration@jwm2013.com

d) Registration Photographs

- All team managers, pilots, helpers and supporters are asked to provide a digital photograph (Passport style) of chest and head only, 1 inch x 1 inch (2 ½ cm x 2 1/2 cm)
- Pasted in the appropriate Forms # 2 or 3
- Due to safety and insurance liability, providing a picture is a must and will be used to produce the official identification passes for use during the event, as well for the Event Brochure
- Unfortunately, we cannot issue any passes without pictures. So any person who does not provide a photograph **will not be** issued a pass and will have limited or no access to facilities and restricted areas on the contest site and the airfield facilities

e) Photo Identification Pass Distribution

- During the on-site registration/check-in process, we will ask the team managers to pick up the passes for their team members

f) Airfield Access Limitations

- The active flying airfield will require separate access for the pilot's helpers and supporters
- Spectators will be restricted from the active flying airfield. Their admission to the JWM competition will be free of charge
- Spectators will be permitted into the model storage hangar; however they will be required to stay within the barricaded walkway areas (they will not be permitted to the model table area)

g) Registration Questions

- All communications with the organizers must be through the team managers.
- Information collected on the registration forms will be used by the organizers solely for the necessary purposes of controlling the event. Your personal data records are confidential

Names, countries and aircraft photos will be used for the publications, event brochure, and announcer commentary

10. National flags and anthems

Each national team is requested to bring:

- One standard outdoor national flag with grommet holes (see photo below) on the top and bottom of the width side of the flag for securing to a pole
- Flag dimensions should be approximately 900 mm width by 1500 mm length (or 3 ft width by 5 ft length)
- a CD (or mp3 file) of your country's national anthem
- those items will be collected during arrival and registration process at the flying site at august 21st and august 22nd from the team manager

11. Fuel, Gas, Compressed Air

- Due to airline restrictions on the transportation of jet fuel and oil, supplies will be available on-site for competitors to obtain and mix their own fuel
- The organising committee calculate with an individual budget and a need of 20 ltr jerrycan Jet A1fuel and 1ltr of turbine oil, specific order for each team is made at the time of the official registration and paid during the registration at the airfield at the beginning of the contest in local currency Swiss Franc CHF.
- Power plugs for air compressors are delivered by the organisers for each team at their own place in the model hangar

12. Alternative Runway/Training

- Due to the location of the Air Force Base, there is no alternate runway available. Practice flight times will be available for each pilot prior to competition start

13. Insurances

- By the Swiss Aeromodelling Association for all the pilots and helpers at flying practice, insurance cover the pilots and helpers by liability insurance during their training practice and contest flights
- Supporters, fans and accompanying peoples e.g photographs need their own insurances (health, liability, legal expences etc.) du to travelling, car driving, excursions and all other and more private activities

14. Passports/Visas/Immigration

- All international travellers must be in possession of a valid passport (preferably one that is valid for at least 6 months after the 2013 JWM)
- Check your status for travelling to Switzerland under the following website <http://www.bfm.admin.ch/content/bfm/en/home/themen/einreise/fag.html>
- Each competitor, helper, family member or supporter is responsible for their own immigration process to enter Switzerland

15. Security passes and restricted areas

- Photo security badges will be made for each team manager, pilot, helper, and supporter
- Only those individuals with the photo security badges will be permitted access to the models in the “Model Storage Hangar” behind the security fence for the spectators
- Any photo security badge holder may escort a guest to the model area. However, the escort must remain with the guest and is responsible for the actions of the guest
- Overnight security will be provided at the event site by the organizer
- During the night, the airfield is closed and protected by guard of the Swiss Government and airfield authority

16. Payments and Bank Transfers

- After the Team Managers return the Registration Forms, we will send each Team Manager an invoice with the exact amount to be transferred. All payments must be made by one transfer for each team

17. Updates

18. Family and Friends

- All family members and friends must be registered as supporters. We will not allow any other visitors to go into the restricted areas on the Meiringen Air Force Base and the model hangar or the flying area

19. Electricity on site

- On the site and in the hangars you will have access to 50Hz/230Volt power (the European standard). Each team may wish to bring a power converter and plug adapters to the special Swiss standard outlet (find it at your local DIY-Store)



- The organizers will provide a limited amount of 12 volt DC inverters for team use

20. Last Day - Air Show

- We don't need the pilots' cooperation and participation, but we are proud and it is helpful if a participant like to fly after the Jet World Masters 2013 before the Closing Ceremony, please let us know
- Please check the Website (www.jwm2013.com) for more information during the contest and the daily news during the Team Managers Meeting

21. Model Crates (Transport and Shipment)

Team Members:

- Each pilot must determine and arrange for the most advantageous air cargo shipment company to transport their model crate from the home country to Switzerland and return to the origin for both legs
- If you have select FedEx, UPS or DHL, they will transport door-to-door
- If you choose a commercial airline (such as: Swiss, Lufthansa, American Airlines, Delta, Air France, United Airlines, British Airways, Singapore Airlines, Air China etc.), don't forget that the transport together with the pilot/team/supporters may cause problems due to special airline security precautions
- All airlines at the Zurich International Airport will charge a handling fee/terminal Fee for processing the import/export of each crate
- The crates should be scheduled for delivery by your own transportation forwarder to Meiringen Air Force Base no later than August 16, 2013
- Crates arriving later than August 16 may be charged a higher delivery fee to the Air Force Base in Meiringen depending on the number of loads and the special circumstances
- The return of the crates to their origins will be exactly the reverse of the original shipment. All return shipping fees with an Air Way Bill (AWB) must be done at the time of your original shipping arrangements at your home country

The model crate shipping labels to Switzerland should read:

- A return address label for your model crate must be provided by each pilot at the conclusion of the JWM and affixed to the model crate by the pilot
- Shipments by any other means or car/camper/truck must be handled directly by the model owner or pilot

- Each pilot should investigate with their own country any advance registration required of the model to ensure there are no import or export issues. The pilot will want to ensure the model can be easily received in their home country on return shipment and not be subjected to a duty tax

22. Spectators and guests

- For the benefit of spectators and guests, special barriers and passages will be provided inside the model storage hangar which will allow the spectators to view the models and pilots up close
- It will be at a reasonably safe distance with security and thus allowing good close access to all the models. Only properly photo badged team managers, pilots, helpers, and supporters or specially badged media peoples may have the clearance to go beyond the security fence inside the model storage hangar and special passages
- The same restrictions are valid for the TWY and RWY access, supporters are not allowed to enter the RWY area at the contest site

- One of the organizer's representatives will be waiting for you in the Information Office at the Meiringen Airbase to make sure you arrived safely and that you know how to get to your hotel or camping ground.

Excursion Activities

- The organizer will provide a choice of activities upon arrival on all the available excursion activities that your team may participate in while here for the JWM

- The same information is available on the JWM website www.jwm2013.com from september 2012, first promotion during the Jet Power Fair in Bad Neuenahr/Germany from september 16th to september 18th
- You may desire to rent a car while your stay in Switzerland. Train/rail service and bus transportation is well available as it can't be found in many other countries

- Between Meiringen City Center (most of the hotels) and the airfield there is a public bus connection, riding time 15 minutes from the railway station to the airfield
