The Judges may ask the contestants questions about the model and the full-size original.

4.0.3 Static judging of 'Fidelity to Scale and Craftsmanship'	
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A maximum of 20 minutes is to be spent for the scale jet classes and 15 minutes is to be spent for all other classes on the static judging of every model. (In case of two judges panels: Items (a) to (d) - 7 minutes, item (e) to (j) – 13 minutes for scale jets and 8 minutes for all other classes.) The watch shall be stopped when the model is repositioned. The Judges may ask the contestants questions about the model and the full-size original.	

Reason: As tested at the JWM 2025, it has shown to be more suitable for the jet scale classes.

6.0.x	Vintage bonus (25 points max) The vintage bonus allows contestants to choose older prototype subjects without being at a disadvantage. The date of the first flight as published on http://en.wikipedia.org determines the vintage. The date used will be that of the first flight of the original aircraft whether the model is of the original aircraft, of a restored aircraft, or of a replica. The most points are awarded to a pre 1940 model (25 points) and for every year (decade) the date of first flight is later, 1 (5) point(s) less is awarded, so we end up at 1 (5) point(s) for a 1964 (1970-1979) first flight and zero points for any year thereafter. Silhouette Class	<p>New class to introduce and encourage pilots to compete in the World Jet Masters. Any jet that is commercial available of a full size jet would be considered, but it has to be within 85% scale outline an in a scale paint scheme. A 3-view drawing and top, side and front view photos would need to be provided in the scale paint scheme, but not in depth for judging. This would new pilots an insight to the static judging as required for the other classes, but would only make up 10% of their overall score.</p> <p>The flying score would be 90% over 3 rounds and all rounds would be added together for scoring.</p> <p>This class would only be open to new pilot and can only be entered once and if they wish to compete again, they would have to move up to basic, 15/20kg classes etc.</p> <p>I envisage that this would encourage new pilots to take up the competition after talking to pilots who would be interested in taking part, but cannot invest the time or money in constructing a World Masters jet</p>
