Welcome to the 15th IJMC Jet World Masters

We welcome all competing jet pilots and helpers, their family-members and supporters, as well as all jet aeromodelling enthusiasts, to the 15th IJMC Jet World Masters, to take place in Skien, Norway at the airfield of the Jetmodellklubb Skien.

This Draft Bulletin focuses on your proper team registration, accommodation and worthwhile information during your stay in the Skien/ Telemark region.

The official language of the competition and related publications will be English.

All information will be available on the IJMC website www.lJMC.net, especially all necessary documents for registration can be downloaded there. At a later date, the JWM website of the Skien Jet Modellkubb and Facebook account will also be available, which will provide you with further useful information about the Telemark region.

The official currency in Norway is Norwegian Krone (NOK). The exchange rate of 1NOK corresponds to 0.085€, or 1NOK corresponds to 0.090\$.

The official registration of the nations can be done from the beginning of the new year 2025 until the registration deadline of May 31st, 2025.



2. Location



The City of Skien is located just 140km in the south-west of Oslo.

It is located in the Telemark region and in the City of Skien are living approx. 56.000 inhabitants. The international airport of Oslo-Gardemoen or international airport of Torp-Sandefjord are the best options to arrive Skien via plane.

To reach Skien by car, motorhome or caravan, you can either take the Kiel-Oslo ferry or the fast ferries from Denmark (Hirthals) to Larvik (Norway) or Kristiansand (Norway). The ferry from Hirthals to Larvik is particularly recommended because it is fast and inexpensive.

The ferry from Kiel to Oslo takes approx. 20 hours for the crossing and costs approx. 300€ one way, the fast ferry from Hirthals to Larvik costs approx. 140€ one way for a car and two people and takes approx. 3.5 hours for the crossing. The ferry connections can be booked online at www.colorline.com. It is advisable to book the ferries as soon as possible, as the routes are very busy in the summer months.

Important information about the IJMC JWM

In addition to the well-known Jet Scale (15 and 20kg) and the Turbo Prop class, two new classes will be integrated into the IJMC JWM for the first time in Norway; the Basic Jet Scale Demo class and the Giant class, which allows models up to a total weight limit- wet- of 150kg.

The new competition classes will most likely lead to an increase in the total number of pilots. A simulation of the total number of pilots across all competition classes has resulted in a **maximum of approx. 70 pilots** who can be admitted to the competition in the targeted competition period from Monday to Saturday midday.

Should this number be significantly exceeded by the registration deadline, admission to the competition will be determined on the basis of the registration date received. The current official competition classes Jet Scale and Turbo Prop Class will have priority over the Basic Jet Scale Demo Class and the Giant Class. The IJMC will nevertheless endeavor to allow all classes to participate. If the maximum number of 70 pilots is exceeded, a waiting list will be created, which will offer the possibility to move up in the event of cancellations by corresponding pilots.

Time simulation


Assumptions:

Flight time: 12+1min. Static time: Scale Jets:20+5min. Basic, TP, Giant: 15+5min.

Number of contestants:

Basic Scale : 10 Turboprop : 5 Jets 15kg : 10 Jets 20kg : 25 Giant Scale : 20

Net flight time per day: 8,5 hours. (Saturday: 3hours).

A maximum of roughly 70 pilots participating in all classes might be manageable within 3 flight rounds. This number will be taken as the reference for the number of entries approved for the JWM 2025. In terms of bad weather conditions the flight rounds will be limited to two or the last third flight round will be limited to the best 50% pilots of each class. The decision will be taken on-site by voting of the pilots.

5. Registration of Pilots/ Teams

The registration of pilots of <u>all classes</u> Jet Scale (15 and 20kg), Turbo Prop, Basic Jet Scale and the Giant class is done via the Contestant Declaration Sheet _V6, which is available for download on the IJMC.net website. This Contest Declaration Sheet must be completed <u>by each pilot</u> and sent beforehand to the Contest Director fsdohrmann@gmx.de and to the Scoring Officer knoerrg@t-online by e-mail. Preferably the contest declaration sheets for the different teams shall be sent via the Team Manager by each nation.


The Giant Class pilots are kindly asked to send the sheets directly.


The replies will be used to determine the field of participants and the number of participating pilots in the run-up to the World Championships. If the maximum number of pilots is exceeded, the waiting list will be drawn up. When entering the originality bonus, please take into account the new list from 2024, which already includes the bonus points of the Turbo Prop as well.

In preparation for the JWM, pilots are <u>demanded</u> to fill in the flight and static judging sheets and bring them to the World Championships physically printed. It is not considered and possible to print the scoring sheets onsite in Skien.

The corresponding flight maneuvers must be sorted by group and compared again in the cluster for flights maneuvers 2025.


A second important document for country registration and additionally the Giant Class registration must be completed in order to determine the fees per nation and also for the individual Giant Class pilots.

As a reminder, the Giant Class pilots will not be registered via the team but will fly as individual pilots.

The team manager of each nation will fill in the Country Registration sheet for his nation without the Giant Class pilots. From this document the invoices per nation and the pictures for the badges of the pilots, helpers and supportes will be taken.

The invoices and the pictures for the badges of the Giant class pilots, helper and supporter of the Giant class pilots will be created based on the Giant class registration sheets seperately.

All country registration and Giant class registration forms are available and ready for download on the www.IJMC.net website. As the registration forms include some specific features, e.g. introduction of pictures in a .pdf document, the user is kindly asked to carefully read the associated document "INFO registration countries Pilots & Giant Class 2025".



7. Competition Site

The photos below of the Skien airfield provides an overview of the key facilities supporting the event



The paved runway in the middle of the picture has a length of roughly 400mtr., the runway orientation is from east to west, the frequent wind direction will be from right to left (east to west), the take-off and landing approach is free from obstacles. The flight corridor is situated over the trees above.




This pictures shows the proposed location of the different tents, campground, parking lots and separation with security fences.

The infrastructural means are shown schematically. The exact positions and distances will be published in a future issue of the Bulletin.

The paved runway is separated from a parallel 3mtr high little embankment. The distance between runway and little embankment is appr. 15mtr.



The sun movement during the course of the day is entirely behind the pilots. Daylight will be available until 9:00pm in the evening so that there might be possibilities to recover flight time in case of bad weather conditions.

Storage Hangar tents

- Two storage hangar tents will be set-up with a total amount of 650sqm., inside the tents tables will
- not be provided by the organizer. The pilots are asked to bring their own foldable tables or model holders with them.
- Chairs and seating equipment will not be provided
- During the night, the tents will be closed, but not locked. Security task is taken by the local organization staff. The campers of the security staff will be located around the storage tents.
- There will be some points inside the tents provided with electricity, so batteries can be charged. Unattended charging, or charging overnight is forbidden.

Camping Ground

- Camping ground is located in front of the cafeteria with a total size for roughly 50 campers and trailers.
- Electricity on the camp ground is provided and will be included in the camping fee of 300NOK (equals appr. 25€) per night. The number of people inside the camper or trailer doesn't matter.
- The water supply point is on the side of the cafeteria (TBC) and may be used for normal consumption free of charge
- Moveable shower cabins and toilets specifically for the camp ground will be set-up.
 The availability of a tub to empty the chemical toilet of the camper or trailer needs to be confirmed, at least it can be emptied in the moveable toilets. (TBC)

Electricity socket type

• Norway uses the standard Euro socket with two round pins so that the type C or F adpater (North europe adapter) can be used.

9. Specific Information about Registration & Fees

9.1 Pre-Registration information

All team managers are kindly requested to send a pre-information on which nations and approximate number of pilots will participate by the end of February at the latest. The exact number of pilots and nations will be determined in the official registration process. The approximate number of pilots and participating countries should only serve as an indication for the organizer. The information provided in the pre-information is not binding for the official registration process due until may 31st, 2025.

The pre-information is kindly asked to be send to fsdohrmann@gmx.de and knoerrg@t-online.de.

9.2 Official Registration Process

In order to channelize the information exchange the communication will be accepted only via the national team managers for the Jet Scale, Turbo Prop and Basic Jet Scale class pilots. The Giant class pilots may route their questions directly to the specific focal points.

Entry fees:

•	Team manager	250 €/ nation
•	Competitor (Jet Scale, TP, Basic class)	400 € each*
•	Competitor (Giant class)	400 € each*
•	Helper	150 € each
•	Supporter	75 € each
•	Junior Supporter < 16y	free of charge

*if a pilot is competing in two classes (Giant class and TP class or Giant class and Basic class) he has to pay an entry fee of only 600€ for both classes.

Registration forms:

- Final registration date (team manager, pilots, helpers) is 31st May 2025, supporters may registered until July 31st, 2025
- All completed team registration forms shall be submitted by team managers only.
 Giant Class pilots may send the completed registration forms directly.
- The team managers of each nation are kindly asked to fill in the "Registration Form Nation Team Pilots"
- The individual Giant Class pilots have to fill in the "Registration Form Giant class pilot"
- All forms should be sent to: fsdohrmann@gmx.de and knoerrg@t-online.de
- After the registration you will get an invoice from the organizer. The registration is valid after payment.
- Your prompt registration helps to ensure your acceptance as a competitor
- Early registration will also support us in providing the best possible preparation for your arrival
- The registration fee includes attendance of the competition and a welcome aperitif for competitors and TM (TBC). Fuel and other expenses are not included.

 Any other orders and vouchers for social activities (such as Nations Night and the Closing Ceremony) are to be paid during the JWM event, latest 2 days before the event will happen.

Transportation of the model boxes:

- The transportation of the model boxes via airplane can be arranged with the logistic specialist from Netherlands <u>www.globallogistics.com</u>.
 - The company will help in terms of customs affairs as well.
- Trond is offering to send the boxes to his workshop and also to store them there.

10. Fuel, Oil, Training, Airshow

Fuel

Orders for fuel must be submitted with the registration form.

The fuel will be provided from a large big barrel. Pilots are asked to bring their own empty refueling station.

Oil

Due to different preferred oil brands on the market, pilots are asked to bring their own oil.

Training

The training slots per team will be made after drawing in the order of sequence during the arrival of all teams on Thursday evening during the first team managers meeting. The training slots for the Jet Scale (15 and 20kg), Turbo Prop and Basic Jet Scale Demo class will take place on Friday 22nd August 2025 from 9:00am to the evening. Each pilot per team will get an amount of 10min. The total amount of time is the result of multiplication by the number of team pilots. If a single pilot is competing for one nation he will get 20min for his slot.

The training slots for the Giant class pilots will be done on Saturday morning. The order of sequence will also been drawn in a dedicated meeting. Each giant class pilot will get 15-20min for his slot depending from the total amount of registered giant class pilots. The training of the Giant class pilots is part of the airshow on Saturday morning until afternoon.

Airshow on Saturday and Sunday, 23rd and 24th of August

On Saturday and Sunday, 23 and 24 August, there will be a big airshow organized by Trond Hammerstad and his team. Top national and international pilots will be present, such as the Red Bull Aerobatics team. The airshow will mainly be supported by the Giant Class pilots, whose training slots will be integrated into the program on Saturday morning. Pilots from other classes are also allowed to participate but NOT with their competition models, as the official training has already taken place on Friday. The IJMC is NOT responsible for the organization and execution of the airshow.

Opening Ceremony on Sunday evening, 24th of August

On Sunday evening, when the airshow is finished, there will be the official opening ceremony of the IJMC JWM 2025 on the airfield. The IJMC and the Head of Organization will make every effort to provide a festive setting. As usual, the flags of the participating nations, the participating pilots together with their helpers and the officials will be welcomed.

The Team Managers are kindly asked to bring their national flags with them. As usual a rectangular format with an approximately size of 1.5 x 1mtr. is recommended. If a Giant class pilot is NOT represented by an already participating team the Giant class pilot is kindly asked to bring his national flag.


16. RV Parking in Skien
